Dear father and Mother i have neglected writing for
some time for their was not much use to write we have
about six inches of snow it is thawing today it is very pleasant
we are all well and able to eat our allowance Ed and marthy
are well wheat 1.59 cuts 32 cents corn 56 cents potatoes 45 cents
apples 1 dollar a bushel all other kinds of produce a fair price
pork four dollars 50 huf 5 dollars cows from twenty to 40
dollars a head aspen from 80 to 150 a yoke horses very high
our buggy come thru with out much damage it was on the
road about four weeks the fruit was 11 dollars i got an
advertisement from ones of his farm and would like to here
all the particulars about the sail tel ones to write what
he is a going to do if he comes west to come and see us
tel henry and jim and asa and unan emily and edmond
to write all the news and write soon see the boys
to come out it is good fishing out here and plenty of game
we here the news from lockport every week it must
look rather muggy down there since the red flames ticked
up part of the present town we have no school here yet
we have our school meeting to morrow night
