

June 26, 1870

Dear Uncle Ezra, I have  
sat down to write you once  
more, we heard that you was  
yet living, by the way of Ara  
victory Janet, in Farmington  
in the spring I have been  
thinking ever since that I  
would write you, thinking  
you would answer the letter  
immedi<sup>ately</sup> as you generally  
have when I write to you  
I was glad to hear of your good  
health and spirits, thinking,  
that when your work was done  
on Earth, you would meet  
the "Welcome applauded,  
enter thou into the joy of thy Lord"

I feel with you, that our work  
on Earth, is almost done, but fear  
little, it matters not if we are ready,  
and prepared to meet the Bridegroom  
our healths are not very good,  
Mr Stoughton's health is very poor  
the Friends are well as far as  
I know, I do not hear from  
our Friends, in Shiloh wassa, very  
often, I have not heard from  
Josiah since you wrote me,  
if he lives near you please  
tell him, I have been looking  
for that letter, a great while  
I was very sorry that I could  
not see Asa, when he was  
in Mahan, Janet said  
she had a good visit with  
him,

we are having extreme warm  
weather here, and dry so  
crops are light on the account  
there will not be half the  
fruit, there generally is,  
we are yet living in P Paw  
and expect to, while we live  
we enjoy priviledges here that  
we could not in the Country  
we have enough of this  
world, to carry us through if  
we make good use of it,  
we have \$1 hundred at interest  
and our little home here,  
it is all we want of this world  
but we want to make sure,  
of an interest in Heaven,  
Your uncle how glad we should  
be if you would come and  
visit us once more

It seems as though you  
might come, Delema and  
family has gone to St Johns,  
to live in the Village where  
Brother Loryth died  
they sold out here and bought  
a printing press, he Edits  
a paper called the Clinton  
Republican, they think they  
are going well, we are very  
lonesome, since they went away  
with Dear Uncle I must  
stop writing for this time,  
after asking you to write  
when you get this,  
give my love to all your  
family and Brother J,
