farmers have got their grain sowed, and some is up. quite a lot of buildings have been built here this Spring. pa has plastered several. they will commence making cheese in a <sup>at the cheese factory.</sup> week or two. last summer the timber had about 16 scholars, now there is 90. the grass has just got up high enough for cattle to get a living on.
