Dear Grandpa

as you is very busy at work I thought I would write, we are all well at present, and hope this will find you the same.

We are having real rainy weather now. I go to school My teacher's name is Mr Lewis. I study Circles Geography, Robinsons Arithmetic, National Fifth Reader National Speller, & Keels Grammar. I go to Sunday School. There are 111 people go some Sundays. A young lady is going to Rock Singing School here in a few days, I am going. The price is one Dollar for 10 lessons.

Farmers have got their grain stored, and some is up. quite a lot of buildings have been built here this Spring. You has plastered several. They will commence making cheese ^{at the cheese factory} in a week or two. last summer the teacher had about 16 scholars, now there is 90. The grass has just got up high enough for cattle to get a living on.
