Dear Grandpa.

I received your letter quite a while ago, and was glad to get it. We are all well as usual. it is quite cold this morning, James and I go to school now. We haven't heard from Fred for about a month.

There is a Steam flow at wells now, it cost ~~1~~⁵ 6000. It will turn 6 fans, each 20 inches wide. They just started it last night. Col-Thompson came to wells last night. I guess I will have to stop writing. There don't seem to be any news ~~at wells~~. I just thought I would write a few lines to let you know we hadn't forgotten you.
