June 15 1871

Dear Grandpa.

I received your letter quite a while ago, and was glad to get it. We are all well as usual. It is quite cold this morning. Frances and I go to school now. we havent heard from Fred for about a month.

There is a Steam plow at wells now. it cost ~~\$6000~~.
It will turn a furrow, each 10 inches wide. They just started it last night. Col. Thompson come to wells last night. I guess I will have to stop writing. There dont seem to be any news ~~now~~. I just thought I would write a few lines to let you know we havent forgotten you.
