EZRA WARREN

An Old Veteran Fallen.

Mr. Ezra Warren, born November 1789, in Woodstock, Vt., died on the 12th of November, 1879, at the residence of his son, Henry Warren, in Cambria, Niagara county, N. Y., "an old man and full of years." He came to Cambria 67 years ago. He was converted in his 35th year, united on probation with the M. E. Church, and proved his allegiance to his new master by toiling successfully many years as an evangelist. His strength failing about three years ago, he realized a constant longing to be with Jesus, saying: "My satchel is all packed and I am ready to go." Twenty-two years ago his dear companion preceded him to the Spirit Land. His constant theme was, Jesus as he trod the lonely way. About a year ago he selected his funeral text, "I am ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought a good fight. I have finished my course. I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give to me on that day; and not to me only, but unto all them that love his appearing." II Tim., IV. 6-8. His work being done he became restless to depart.

I'm restless my paradise mansion to see."

After nearly ninety winters he calmly leaned his head on Jesus breast and breathed his life out sweetly there. Having visited him a day or two before he gave us a patriarchial blessing, saying "May your fruit be unto holiness and the end everlasting life." We bore his mortal remains to the city of the dead till Jesus comes and bids him rise.

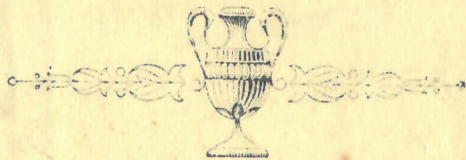
